**REPORT ON NSS SPECIAL CAMP HELD AT GOLLAPUDI VILLAGE,
GOLLAPUDI GRAM PANCHAYATHI, VIJAYAWADA
(26-02-2020 to 03-03-2020)**

PSCMR NSS unit organized a special camp in the adopted village, Gollapudi from 26-02-2020 to 03-03-2020. This special camp was organised with the help of Rotaract Club of Gollapudi and supported to identify the problems at Gollapudi Village. The main project for this camp was based on, to create awareness to improve the health and hygiene conditions of Gollapudi public. The Volunteers of the NSS unit performed many other activities – awareness programmes as literacy, tree plantation, communal harmony etc.

Day-1

The forenoon session of the Day began with a Procession by volunteers in the village. Volunteers rallied into the streets of the village to create awareness among the villagers about the ensuing special camp programme in their village for a period of one week. This was followed by an inauguration Program held at High School of Village. The programme was started with lightening the lamp and NSS song. Village authorities welcomed the team of Volunteers into their village. During the Afternoon of the First Day Volunteers interacted with Village people and visited the people in their houses. Created awareness on how to prevent Corona virus by washing hands, usage of masks. Also Volunteers created awareness through door to door campaign on cleanliness, spread of diseases, importance of environment and judicious use of Electricity, water harvesting and importance of ground water. After taking dinner volunteers discussed the project agenda and activities with NSS programme officer.

Day - 2

In the dawn of the second Day, volunteers started their campaign by contacting those villagers who were going for open defecation they made them aware about the diseases caused by open defecation. Also made aware on Health and Hygiene. In the day time a survey was conducted to know the basic toilet facilities in the houses, Observing Hygiene conditions of the villagers. In the camp volunteers organised a Shramadanam Programme. About 50 volunteers divided themselves into sub groups and went into the streets, lanes and by lanes of the village and organized a cleanliness drive. Volunteers cleaned the village roads.

Day-3

The Forenoon Session of third day began with door to door contact with village people for the use of toilets and avoids the habits of open defecation. Volunteers also identified those village people who do not have toilet facility in their homes. The afternoon session Literacy programme was conducted at Mandal Parishad Upper Primary School at Gollapudi to empower the knowledge of school children.

Day - 4

The subject of fourth day camp was aware on usage of water, Check tap leaks and Turn off the water while brushing teeth etc. Volunteers rallied into the streets of the village to create awareness on save water.
