#### A Report on Blood Grouping:

A blood group is commonly performed as part of a group of tests. These tests include ABO and RhD blood groups, a blood group antibody screen and a cross match. There are over 200 different blood groups known. The most important ones are the ABO and the RhD blood groups. These are routinely determined prior to transfusion and during pregnancy. These two blood group systems also determine the eight most common blood types: A Positive, A Negative, O Positive, O Negative, B Positive, B Negative, AB Positive and AB Negative. The ABO blood groups are extremely important when receiving a blood transfusion. There are some blood groups (e.g. group O Negative, the 'universal donor') that can be given to almost any other person. However other blood groups (e.g. group AB) must only be transfused to people of the same blood group in order to prevent a potentially fatal transfusion reaction.




Fig: College Precident Sri. Chalavadi Mallikarjuna Rao Garu Distributing Books for Poor Children's




Fig 1: On the day Students are participated in Essay Writing and Poster presentation Events.





#### A Report on Blood Grouping:

A blood group is commonly performed as part of a group of tests. These tests include ABO and RhD blood groups, a blood group antibody screen and a cross match. There are over 200 different blood groups known. The most important ones are the ABO and the RhD blood groups. These are routinely determined prior to transfusion and during pregnancy. These two blood group systems also determine the eight most common blood types: A Positive, A Negative, O Positive, O Negative, B Positive, B Negative, AB Positive and AB Negative. The ABO blood groups are extremely important when receiving a blood transfusion. There are some blood groups (e.g. group O Negative, the 'universal donor') that can be given to almost any other person. However other blood groups (e.g. group AB) must only be transfused to people of the same blood group in order to prevent a potentially fatal transfusion reaction.

On the Occasion of Blood Group Identification on 28<sup>th</sup> Aug 2017 a blood camp was organized by Department of Management Studies, PSCMR COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY, Vijayawada in association with Red Cross Society at 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
