All the members appreciated getting the awards and rankings for the institution. Also, they appreciated presenting all the activities that happened at the institution.

For further improvement, the council members gave the following suggestions to take up in the present second semester of the Academic Year 2025-26.

1. It is suggested to conduct internal examinations again for the students who were absent for the mid-term examinations due to medical reasons or any other emergency situations. The same may be conducted only after verifying the genuineness of the reasons submitted by the students.
2. It is suggested that faculty should not provide important questions to the students, as this may lead them to prepare only selective topics instead of the complete syllabus, which could result in a lower pass percentage in that subject.
3. It is recommended to identify slow learners in each subject of the II semester for the academic year 2025-26 and to provide them with special classes to enhance their

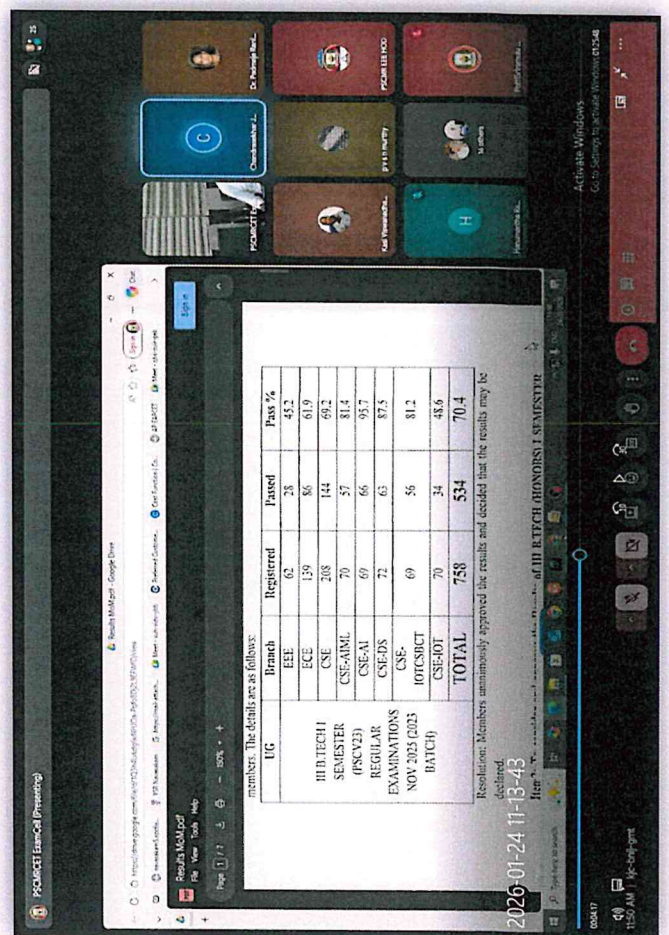
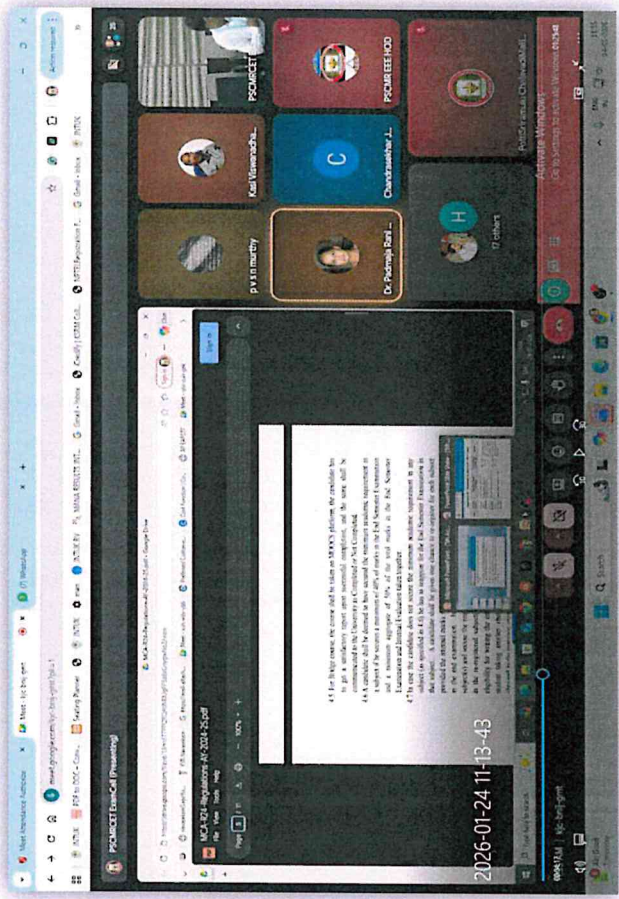
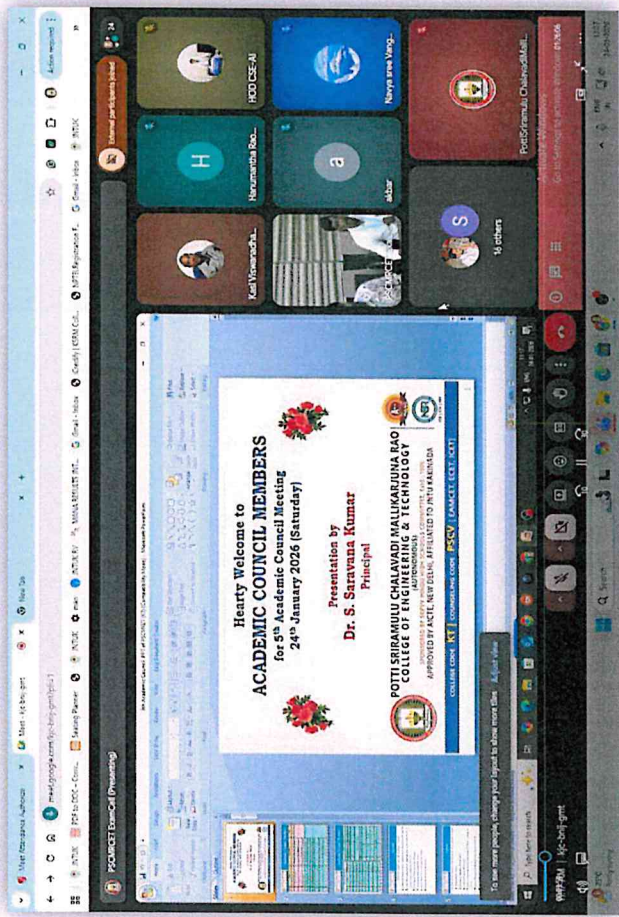
- performance and pass percentage (Especially in the branches where they are under performed like EEE, ECE and CSE-IOTCSBCT)
4. It is suggested to add a column for eligible students in the placement statistics to accurately determine the placement percentage
 5. It is recommended that all faculty members register on Vidwan, create their Scopus ID, and ensure that their publications are properly updated and reflected in their IRIS profiles and suggested to show the faculty publication in IRMS screen in the next presentation
 6. It is suggested to maintain regular contact with the council members to receive timely updates on activities.
 7. The JNTUK Nominee emphasized that the academic regulations must be strictly followed. Further, it was suggested to guide PG students in selecting appropriate NPTEL and MOOC courses, in accordance with the JNTUK R25 Regulations, to improve their self-learning competence
 8. Mr. Rama Krishna Dasari, CEO, Efftronics Pvt. Ltd., Vijayawada asked to share the IoT syllabus. Additionally, it was suggested to offer bridge courses in Physics and Mathematics for the I B.Tech students
 9. Suggested to update the faculty web page in the website so the institution will come in to limelight.
 10. It is suggested to teach the subject starting from the basics and fundamental concepts rather than using a general approach. This will help students develop a stronger foundation and enable them to solve problems of higher difficulty levels

The chairman thanked all the members for their valuable inputs and the invaluable time they spent on the institution's development and the provision of quality education to the students and finally concluded the meeting.
